WINNING TIME: REGGIE MILLER VS. THE NEW YORK KNICKS INDIANAPOLIS PREMIERE, FEB. 26

INDIANAPOLIS – A Special Movie Premiere Event benefitting three local charities will take place Friday, Feb. 26, 2010 at Conseco Fieldhouse when the film, “Winning Time: Reggie Miller vs. The New York Knicks” is shown.

Part of ESPN Films’ “30 for 30” Documentary Series, “Winning Time: Reggie Miller vs. The New York Knicks” is directed by filmmaker Dan Klores and focuses on the 1994-95 Eastern Conference Semifinal Playoffs, which the Pacers won, four games to three. The film highlights Miller, the Pacers’ all-time leading scorer, and his part in what became a noted playoff rivalry through 2000. The film contains game highlights and interviews from many parties who took part in or witnessed the series.
